see you anymore. - already created

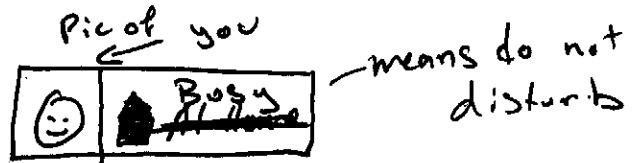
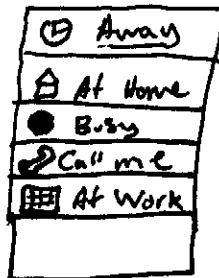
Activity 3: Describe a general GUI design for each of the two features.

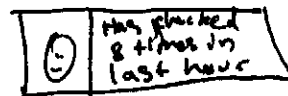


2) Have a Feed that shows who has recently checked your position.
